**STORY**

The modern day Quinta do Arrobe was established in 2011 by the Gaspar family whose viticultural and winemaking roots date back to 1882 when their great grandfather planted his first vineyards in the Tejo region. Located near Santarém, the vineyards are planted on the hillsides of the Tejo River where the soil is comprised of calcareous clay.
