WINE NAME	Casal do Conde Reserva Touriga Nacional – Cabernet Sauvignon
WINERY	Casal do Conde
STORY	Founded by winemaker Manuel Henriques, Casal do Conde, has been rooted on the north bank of the Tejo River since the early 20th century. The company's 75 hectares of vineyards are planted with native Portuguese and international varietals that have been carefully selected for their suitability to the Bairro terroir of Tejo. The estate's commitment to viticulture and investment in the best of modern winemaking technology demonstrate their confidence in the future of the Tejo region as a quality wine-producing region in Portugal.

GRAPE VARIETIES	Touriga Nacional, Cabernet Sauvignon
TASTING NOTES	Intense garnet hue. Notes of blackcurrant, tobacco, purple flowers and spice. The fruit carries through on the palate with additional notes of vanilla and toast. The tannins are fine yet firm providing great structure.
FOOD PAIRING	Goes well with grilled meats, particularly lamb
