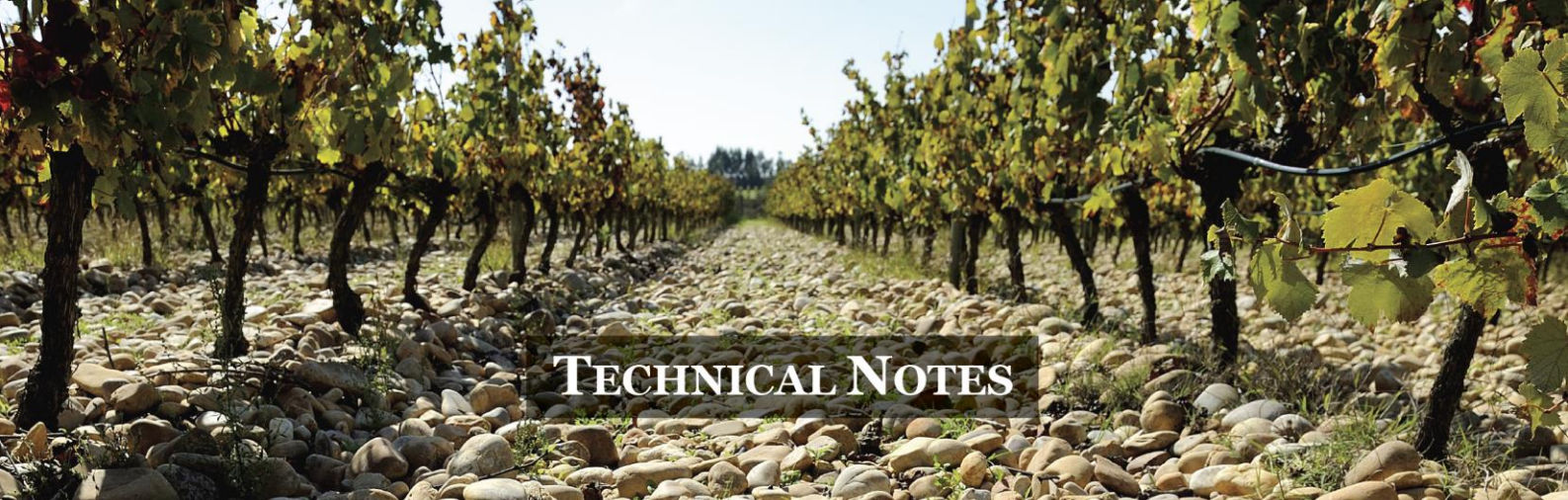




TECHNICAL NOTES

WINE NAME	Vale de Lobos Late Harvest
WINERY	Quinta da Ribeirinha
STORY	Located in Póvoa de Santarém on the north bank of the Tejo River, Quinta da Ribeirinha has been a family endeavor for over three generations. The 95-hectare estate is located in the heart of the Bairro area of the Tejo region and is comprised of 60 hectares of vineyards planted with native Portuguese and international varietals. The calcareous clay soils, and south-facing vineyards receive the optimal viticultural benefits of the warm continental climate complimented by the influence of the Atlantic Ocean. The Candido family's thoughtful approach to winemaking combines the best of modern and traditional practices focusing on the purest expressions of their terroir and the vintage. The family's dedication to the Tejo region is exemplified in every glass of Quinta da Ribeirinha wine.
